## 2026 JACEM Annual Conference (Spring Research Meeting)

The 2026 Annual Conference (Spring Research Meeting) of the Japanese Association for Chinese Economy and Management Studies (JACEM) will be held on **Saturday, June 6, 2026**, at **Osaka University of Economics** (Osumi Campus). We are pleased to announce that we are now inviting proposals for **individual presentations** as well as **organized panels**.

The conference will be conducted **in person**. Presenters are expected to attend the conference venue on the day of their presentation. However, online presentations may be exceptionally permitted for overseas members, or regular members temporarily residing abroad. In such case, applicants must clearly declare a request for online presentation at the time of submission.

Online presenters will be required to participate in a trial session to ensure the communication environment at a designated date and time prior to the conference. In some circumstances, online presenters may also be asked to submit a pre-recorded presentation video in advance.

### 1. Organized Panel Proposals

Members (including those whose membership applications are currently under review) who intend to organize a panel are requested to submit the **"Organized Panel Proposal Form"** (**call\_group\_2026\_spring.xlsx**). You can download the form from the JACEM website. Also, you may apply using the form attached to this Call for Papers. After completing the required information in the form, the panel representative should submit the form together with the **abstracts of all presentations** to the Program Committee at the email address, [jacem2026s@gmail.com](mailto:jacem2026s@gmail.com).

Each presentation abstract should be prepared on A4-sized, up to four pages. Each panel session should be scheduled for no more than two hours in total, and the order of the chair, discussant(s), and

presenters should be determined in advance.

## 2. Individual Presentations (Open sessions)

Members (including those whose membership applications are currently under review) who intend to present an individual paper are requested to submit the **"Individual Presentation Proposal Form"** ([call\\_indivi\\_2026\\_spring.xlsx](#)). You can download the form from the JACEM website. Also, you may apply using the form attached to this Call for Papers. After completing the required information, submit the form together with a **presentation abstract** (A4 size, up to four pages) to the Program Committee at the email address, [jacem2026s@gmail.com](mailto:jacem2026s@gmail.com).

Furthermore, individual presenters are required to submit a **full paper** in advance. The full paper should be approximately 10 pages (A4 size), and must be submitted to the **Program Committee**, the **session chair**, and the **discussant**. Submitted papers will be posted in PDF format on the JACEM website. The JACEM members can download the paper from the JACEM website for a designated period before and after the conference. Please note that **failure to submit the full paper by the deadline may result in cancellation of the presentation**.

Each presentation will be allocated 50 minutes in total: 30 minutes for the presentation, followed by 20 minutes for comments by discussant and discussion with the floor.

## 3. Deadlines

- **Submission deadline for panel proposals and individual paper presentation (proposal form and abstract): March 16, 2026, at noon (JST)**
- **Deadline for revised abstract for accepted panels: May 23, 2026, at noon (JST)**
- **Deadline for full paper submission for individual paper presenters: May 16, 2026, at noon (JST)**

## 4. Presentation Equipment and Materials

Presentations on the conference day should be delivered using **Windows PCs equipped in the conference room**. Available presentation formats are **PowerPoint and PDF**. To avoid technical issues such as freezes or display errors, presenters are **strongly recommended to use PDF files**, particularly macOS users.

Presentation files can be transferred to the PCs using **USB flash drive (USB Type-C not supported)**. Alternatively, presenters may **email the presentation files** to the Organizing Committee by the day

before the conference. The presentation files will be saved on the desktop of the PCs by the committee.

The Organizing Committee will not distribute handouts on the day of the conference. Presenters who wish to distribute handouts are responsible for preparing and printing them in advance and bringing them to the venue. Printers are not available at the venue.
